OVERVIEW

Cristo Rey High School is a Catholic, collegepreparatory high school with a Professional Work Study Program empowering young men and women of all faiths, from economically challenged families, to graduate from college and achieve a lifetime of success. Cristo Rey Columbus targets under-served youth in central Ohio.

Opened in 2013, Cristo Rey Columbus is the 26th Cristo Rey high school in the United States and will join a network of Catholic high schools throughout the country that make a college-preparatory education accessible to students of all faith denominations in some of the most challenging economic circumstances.

For the 2017-18 academic year, 100% of the Cristo Rey seniors graduated. This was our second graduating class and all of these graduates were accepted into college.

PROFESSIONAL WORK-STUDY PROGRAM

What makes Cristo Rey unique is the Professional Work Study Program that helps fund the students' education. With this innovative educational model, each student works five days per month. School fees are paid by employers for student work, and this comprises the majority of the school budget.

We are blessed and proud to have such an ethnically diverse school. 46% of Cristo Rey Columbus students have at least one parent who was born in another country. In addition, 11% of CRC students were born outside of the U.S. (in 22 different countries).

Cristo Rey families come from 43 different countries including Argentina, Bahamas, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Cameroon, Central African Republic, China, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, England, Ethiopia, Ghana, Guatamala, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, Italy, Ivory Coast, Jamaica, Kenya, Laos, Liberia, Mauritania, Mexico, Nepal, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Republic of Guinea, Rwanda, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somali Democratic Republic, Thailand, Togo, Vietnam, West Africa, and Zambia.

37% of Cristo Rey students speak a language other than English at home, including Akan, Amharic, Ewe, French, Fulani, Ga, Khmer, Laotian, Mai Mai, Mandingo, Maninka, Nepali, Pulaar, Sango, Spanish, Tagalog, Tigrinya, Twi, Urdu, Vietnamese, and Yoruba.
