



Required Summer Physicals for Work Study Program

Per Ohio minor labor law, all students participating in a high school work-study program must receive a physical before beginning work each year. This physical ensures your child is in good health to work, and alerts us to any conditions your child may have that would require his/her worksite to make special accommodations.

Please complete the attached Physician's Certificate for Minor Work Permit, and bring this form to your child's doctor or a neighborhood clinic when you schedule his/her physical exam. This form must be returned to the main office on or before **August 1, 2020**.

There may be opportunities this summer for students to obtain a work permit physical from Nationwide Children's Hospital staff on the Cristo Rey Columbus High School campus.
